VP of Operations

- Volunteers:
 - Putting together program for marching band season- it's labor intensive. Thank you to all the parents who helped build the props. We will still need parent help, but not as much as in the past year
 - Volunteers needed:
 - Parents who have quarter ton pickup trucks and above (Ford F-150 or higher)
 - Need about 4 parents with trucks
 - Please see Randy Selke
 - Randy and Kurt must retire because of term limits. Looking for someone who would like to take on this role so they can shadow Randy and Kurt and train for the upcoming year.
 - Trailer is in amazing shape, and was repaired after it was vandalized last year- it was gator-wrapped and now is solar powered and safety features have been improved.
 - Props are mostly done, kids are starting to practice with them.
 - Safety- precautions are being taken to keep the trailer safe from vandalizing. Patrols are happening.
 - Busses are now natural gas, so there isn't sufficient storage for instruments anymore.
 We need to haul more items on our own. So, there is a need for a second trailer.

 - Working on finding a practice location.
 - Itinerary will be coming in November
- Guide to Competitions- See handout
 - A great resource to know about the competitions and performances
 - Buddy Gifts- Ask your child about it, don't feel like you have to buy everything on the list. Just a snack to help tide them over. Suggested: sweet snack, salty snack, and/ or drink. Don't feel like kids have to buy everything on the buddy's wish list. The max amount to spend is \$10.
