

REHEARSAL ATTIRE

- All winter percussion members must wear athletic wear to each rehearsal (No jeans allowed) Students incorrectly dressed will be sent home.
- HAIR must be pulled up and out of the face for ALL rehearsals.
- Jewelry: rings and dangling earrings are not allowed, as these can cause injury.

PERFORMANCE ATTIRE

- Come in show shirt and adidas pants. Instructors will clarify time to change into uniform.
- HAIR
 - This will be defined to fit the theme of the show.
- NO JEWELRY will be worn at a performance.
- Appropriate undergarments must be worn at all times while in uniform.
- No nail polish other than the assigned team color.

ATTITUDE

- You MUST maintain a positive digital footprint (social media), display a positive attitude during and outside of rehearsal/performances, and refrain from using foul language.
- You must eliminate negative behavior while wearing team wear/uniform... You are representing your teammates, your instructors, your school, your town, and your own reputation.
- Always show respect to teachers, directors, coaches, instructors, parents, captains and fellow members.

SCHOOL

- You are expected to be an exemplary member of the student body- Go to school, be on time to your classes, do your work, follow dress code, be a good example for others.
- YOU. MUST. PASS. YOUR. CLASSES. Tutoring will be allowed and encouraged for any student who is having trouble academically. Let an instructor know ahead of time, and bring a note from teacher to rehearsal.
- Students must have a 2.0 to participate in winter percussion.
- Please schedule make-up tests before school, or on non-rehearsal days.

REHEARSAL

- On time means that the <u>floor is pulled out</u> and <u>equipment has been taken out and set</u> up.
- Schedule all doctor, dentist and other appointments for NON-Rehearsal days. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- No talking on the floor during rehearsal.
- Take care of all equipment maintenance BEFORE rehearsal starts OR during break.
- Clean up after yourselves. THROW YOUR TRASH AWAY! Practice area will be cleaned after each rehearsal.
- NO Cell Phones during rehearsals unless you are on break. They need to be put away in your bag at all times.

NO GUM.

• If you have an issue, please see a captain first. If it does not get resolved by talking to a captain, then speak to an instructor, then band director.

PERFORMANCES

- The instructors may determine you are unable to perform part/all of the show if you
 have not mastered the music and/or drill, or for academic, attendance, or behavioral
 reasons. However, you are still required to attend competition and support/help your
 teammates.
- Keep in mind: when you are at a performance, when you are in uniform, or are wearing El Toro clothing... You are representing your teammates and instructors, your school, your town, and your own reputation.
- Eliminate all negative comments when in uniform and/or El Toro clothing.
- During competitions you will sit together as a team to watch the other performances.
 Be respectful of other teams and do not sit in the bleachers on your phone, do not lay down, no blankets. You are also encouraged to help other teams if they need assistance!

EQUIPMENT

- Music and storage room needs to be kept clean at all times. It is not your room, so
 you may not leave personal items in there. A good drum line starts with a clean and
 organized environment:) Everyone must do their part in keeping the room maintained
 and making sure trash is taken out.
- Treat all equipment as if it is your own personal item.
- Take care of all equipment maintenance BEFORE rehearsal starts OR during break.
- You are responsible for having your equipment at all rehearsals.
- You are responsible for making sure your equipment/instrument, the floor, any props, or generator is loaded for competition. NOBODY leaves until everything is loaded.
- You are responsible for returning in your equipment/instrument in good shape at the end of the season.

ATTENDANCE

It is imperative that you attend all camps, rehearsals and all performances. If you
have a conflict, you and/or your parents need to speak to a coach <u>as soon as you
know about it</u>. Failure to communicate with the Coaches jeopardizes your spot in the
show as you may be placed in alternate status and eventual dismissal from team.

- All rehearsals during Championships week are MANDATORY. No exceptions, unless an absence warrants excusal (family emergency, verified illness, etc.)
- Please schedule all appointments (doctor, dentist, etc.) on non-rehearsal, non-performance days.
- If an emergency arises and you have to leave rehearsal: talk to your coach.
- Injuries that require you to sit out of rehearsal must be accompanied by a doctor's
 note. The note must state the injury, any limitations, and when the student is cleared
 to FULLY perform again. You will be expected to stay and observe all rehearsals, as
 well as attend competitions.
- Illness that requires you to miss rehearsal must be accompanied by note from a doctor.
- If a student misses all/part of a rehearsal immediately preceding a performance that student may be asked to sit out of all or part of the performance. The last rehearsal before each competition is very important!
- If you have been absent and missed learning new drill, <u>you</u> are responsible for learning that or any count changes from a fellow teammate <u>prior to</u> (NOT DURING) the next rehearsal.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS (rehearsal or shows)

 Staff will <u>not</u> hold your personal belongings. If it is valuable, it needs to be left at home.

Winter Percussion Chaperone Duties & Instructions Acknowledgment

Thank you for volunteering your time for our instrumental music program! Your assistance is appreciated. Below is a set of duties and instructions to follow when chaperoning our students.

- 1. Follow all instructions provided to you by the music director & staff. You are expected to stay with your group of students for the entire event.
- 2. Assist the music director and student leaders by taking roll prior to departure from ETHS, performance sites, any stop-over requiring boarding of the bus, and other times as appropriate or instructed.
- 3. Ensure that students remain seated with arms inside the bus and do not become rowdy.
- 4. While at the event, our students are to be courteous to the other bands at all times. No disruptions, yelling or walking around while the other bands are performing. They are to give the other bands the courtesy that they would expect for themselves.
- 5. When arriving at destinations, students are to remain on the bus until they are instructed otherwise.
- 6. Assist with logistics and other issues at the event site, including the loading, unloading and movement of equipment and props.
- 7. If a disciplinary issue arises with a student, contact the music director immediately.
- 8. If basic first aid is necessary, please contact the First Aid Coordinator on your contact list. Check the medical log for restrictions for that student <u>before administering any medication</u>, and record the <u>administration of any medication in the log</u>. Be on the alert for any allergic reactions.
- 9. Prescription medications taken by students are required to be administered by a parent/chaperone. If medication is administered on a school trip, it must be recorded in our medical log, even if it is an over-the-counter medication. In the front of the medical log, there is a list of students with allergies/health issues.
- 10. If an emergency occurs, contact the music director immediately for further instructions. **If appropriate, dial 911 or notify event security first.** If necessary, travel with a music director and student to the hospital.
- 11. The use of foul language, in any form, around our students is unacceptable.
- 12. Refrain from public criticism of individuals, including staff, students, directors, administrators, competitors etc.
- 13. Due to SVUSD insurance guidelines and liability limitations NO SIBLINGS are allowed to travel on the bus with parent chaperones.
- 14. All school and district rules apply on our trips.
